

# Alessandro Veronese

Born in Padova on March 9, 1970.

A Classical Studies High School graduate with a Degree in Law from the University of Padova.

He has been registered in the Padova Bar Association since 2001 and is currently registered in the Register of Lawyers admitted to Higher Court of Appeals, and has been qualified for representation before the Senior Magistracy since 2013.

He is a partner of the MDA Avvocati Associati d'Impresa law firm with offices in Padova in Via Niccolò Tommaseo, n. 78/A and in Venezia–Marghera in Via delle Industrie, n. 19/C, VeGa Parco Scientifico e Tecnologico, Palazzo Lybra [www.mdavvocati.it](http://www.mdavvocati.it)).

He is currently in charge of the firm's Administrative Law Section.

He is a member of the Veneto Region Administrative Lawyers' Association and a member of the Association of Italian, German, and French Administrative Court Judges (A.G.A.T.I.F.).

He currently focuses on administrative law (urban development, building construction, the environment, calls for tender, commerce, energy), and maintains a stable consultancy relationship with Confindustria Venezia, Confindustria Padova, and Confindustria Veneto, representing primarily private companies, public administrations, and public companies.

In 1997, he received his Law Degree from the University of Padova (with thesis in Italian-Veneto and German-Bavarian comparative urban development law; supervisor, Prof. Marino Breganze) after attending (1992-1993) the Faculty of Law of the University of Würzburg (RFT) and specialization courses in German law (constitutional, administrative, and urban development).

In 1998 he was appointed consultant by the Venezia Industrial Union, and assigned to assisting companies in the sector of administrative law in general and urban development law– construction companies in particular. As expressly appointed he concentrates on the study and initial applications of the Single Services Desk for productive activities, taking part in the works of the

Commission set up expressly for the purpose by the Veneto Industrial Federation.

In 1999, after completing law practice, he was employed by the Venezia Industrial Union as a functionary assigned to managing legal relations between industries and public administration.
